Bid opening for concrete/asphalt project work scheduled for June 25

Vandalia, Ohio (June 15, 2009)—Vandalia-Butler City Schools is accepting bids for asphalt and concrete projects that will improve student and visitor safety at three of its schools. Bid opening is scheduled for June 25.

The projects, which are part of the critical upgrade portion of the district's building project, will involve the following:

At Demmitt Elementary School, the front sidewalk and parking lot island will be replaced, and asphalt work on the hard-surface playground will be completed.

At Murlin Heights Elementary School, the cement porch and a portion of the sidewalk will be replaced. This project will be bid as an alternate.

At Smith Middle School, the sidewalk around the building will be replaced.

The projects are being funded through the district's bond issue, which was approved by voters in November 2008. When the district requested voter approval to replace Morton Middle School and renovate Butler High School, it also promised to make critical upgrades at the remaining schools.

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
